Workers' Compensation

If your injury or disability is work-related, your employer's workers' compensation insurance may cover driving evaluations, rehab, and modifications.



Auto Insurance (PIP / Liability Claims)

Funds from personal injury protection (PIP) or settlements may be used for driving rehabilitation and adaptive equipment.



Charitable & Community Organizations

Local chapters of United Way, churches, and other nonprofits may offer grants or assistance. Ask your case manager or local independent living center for referrals.
